The beautifully-restored station at Scruton will once again be bedecked with festive garlands and period-style decorations for our very special celebration of Christmas. The fires will be lit and we'll have festive music, mulled wine and mince pies, hot roasted chestnuts and traditional craft activities such as wreath making and Christmas stocking making to keep little hands busy.

This year, to mark the centenary of the end of the First World War, we also will be welcoming re-enactors from the Durham Pals, who will be recreating the atmosphere at the station 100 years ago, when Scruton's 11 servicemen returned to the village (Scruton is a Thankful Village and lost no-one in the conflict). Volunteers from the Heritage Education Team will also be in character as station staff and villagers from 1918, bringing the station and the stories of the community it served to life in a truly memorable way.
