We hope this will provide the reassurance our customers need."

Christmas plans at the new resort include four festive events which enable visitors to journey through the park amongst snowy trees and twinkling lights, and enjoy rides, attractions and special Santa appearances.

Premium Christmas Packages include an adventure through the winter wonderland, a chance to choose a gift at the 'Elf workshop' and selected family friendly rides from 11am to 4pm along with food and drink options.

Christmas Sleepovers are also on offer for families hoping to extend their magical short break in imaginative themed accommodation options - from lost world lodges to unicorn suites.

Festive Friday Adventures will also be available and will see the park open its selected festive rides from 4pm to 6.30pm, offer a magical walk through the winter wonderland, a North Pole Discovery experience and enable children to choose their own gift in the Elf Workshop. The ticket includes festive food options - from mince pies to a hot turkey roll - and Santa will be sure to make an appearance.

For a delightfully joyous midweek Christmas experience ideal for parents and toddlers, Gulliver's Dancer or Rudolph packages will bring Christmas cheer to all the family. Tickets include indoor attractions from 10.30am to 2pm amongst all the other festive inspired activities on offer.

Premium packages and Festive Fridays start at £19 per person, short breaks start at £199 and Midweek packages start at £17 per person.

Added Julie: "We are also really pleased to announce that we have teamed up with Village Screen which will see a Christmas drive in cinema in the grounds of Gulliver's Valley. It will run from 17-21 December where household bubbles will be able to enjoy some of the best festive movies from the safety of their own car with seasonal catering and drinks also on offer.
